MATH 9500 Approval Form (Graduate Independent Study)

The following rules apply to any graduate student interested in taking a mathematics independent study for credit.

- 1. The student's GPA must be at least 3.3. Any exceptions to this rule must be approved by the chair of the graduate committee.
- 2. Independent study credit-hours may not exceed 25% of the minimum number required for the degree.
- 3. Agreement from a regular faculty member, as well as approval from the chair of the graduate committee and the chair of the department are required before a student may register for an independent study.
- 4. The student and faculty member in question must agree on the material to be covered, the schedule, and the grading procedures in advance of seeking approval from the graduate committee and department chairs.

After obtaining the relevant signatures, this form should be taken to the mathematics program assistant (in ENG 274) to receive a permission number.
